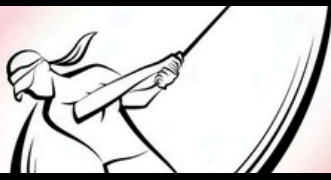

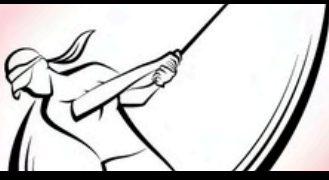

# MEN'S GOLF

## Wednesday at Indian Creek is considered Men's Day.

Hole # 1 tee is open for men only (ages 16+) from 11 am - 7 pm, on Wednesdays starting May 1 through the end of September.

Hole #1 tee is open to anyone before 10:30am and after 7pm on Wednesdays. If starting before 10:30, you are allowed to complete your nine holes. All other facilities including the pro shop, swimming pool, and Creeke Bed will remain available for all members.

## Men's Day Food Options

In the evening, a limited food menu will be available from approximately 5:30 PM – 7:30 PM, pending weather and turnouts.

## MEN'S GOLF LEAGUE ON WEDNESDAYS

### Wednesday Men's Golf League:

We're bringing back Wednesday Golf League starting May 20th. The league will run 7 weeks in total (6-week season + finals).

#### **Format:**

- 2-man Best Ball teams, pick your partner
- Scoring: Net Stableford Points
  - Team earns points based on the better net score between the two players on each hole
- Play anytime Wednesday (5:30 PM encouraged)
- Make-ups allowed Saturday mornings
- GHIN handicap required
- Season-long standings – best 5 of 6 weeks count (in case you miss a week)

#### **Changes from last year:**

- Must play with someone other than your partner to verify your scores

#### **Scoring System:**

- Net Bogey = 0
- Net Par = 1
- Net Birdie = 3
- Net Eagle = 5
- Net Double Eagle = 7
- (Max score = net double. Must hole out. Lift/clean/place within 6".)

#### **Cost:**

- **\$90** per player for the session
- – approx. \$5/week to skins
- – approx. \$5/week to weekly game
- – approx. \$5/week to season-long prizes

**Guests are welcome as a partner**, but must play with a **current member**

– Guests prepay **\$90** additional for 6 weeks of 9-hole green fees (**cart not included**)

**We plan to start Session #2 later this summer. We hope you sign up for both.**

### **JUNIOR RESTRICTIONS ON WEEKENDS & HOLIDAYS**

To ensure an enjoyable experience for all members, junior play is subject to the following weekend and holiday guidelines:

- **Ages 16-17:**
  - No restrictions.
- **Ages 11-15:**
  - May play with an adult before noon.
  - May play without adult supervision after noon.
  - Parents are responsible for ensuring juniors understand and follow proper golf etiquette.
  - Please be courteous and allow faster groups to play through when appropriate.
- **Ages 10 & Under:**
  - Adult supervision required at all times.
  - Please be courteous and allow others to play through when necessary.

We appreciate everyone's cooperation in helping younger players learn and respect the game.

## **8 Inch Cup, 2 Person Best Shot**

- Sunday, June 28th
- Men play red tees, Seniors play from the white tees
- Super Senior/Junior/Ladies Tees play from the blue tees
- \$50 per Player (Member)
- \$60 per Player (Non-Member)
- Open to Public, Sign-Up with a partner
- Limited spots available
- Can sign up with 2 other groups



### **Check In Policy:**

- Register with pro shop staff before starting your round; Tee of hole #1 unless given permission from staff; Notify staff when renting a cart
- Age requirements for cart rental:
  - 18 to rent a cart; 16 to drive a cart with parent supervision or family cart club purchase; 15 and younger not allowed to drive a golf cart

### **Dress Code:**

- Men: ages 16 and over must wear collared golf shirts;
  - This includes a traditional fold down collar, mock turtleneck collar, blade collar, or a raised crew-neck collar which clearly differentiates it from a t-shirt. No t-shirts, jerseys, cutoffs allowed
- Women: must wear appropriate golf attire
- Most forms of outerwear are allowed and jeans are allowed
- No swimming suits. Shirt and shoes must be worn at all times

### **Etiquette:**

- Holes #1 and #10 will alternate using the following rotation:
  - Group teeing off #1 are first in line; then group coming off #9 starting #10 are second in line; the alternating continues until #1 tee opens
- White tees are used for the front nine and red tees used for the back nine
- The light switch on hole #9 is used to notify when the green is in use
- Official ladies tee box on hole #7 and unofficial tee box is available on hole #5
- Pace of play: 1 hour 50 minutes for 9 holes, 3 hours 40 minutes for 18 holes

# POOL INFORMATION

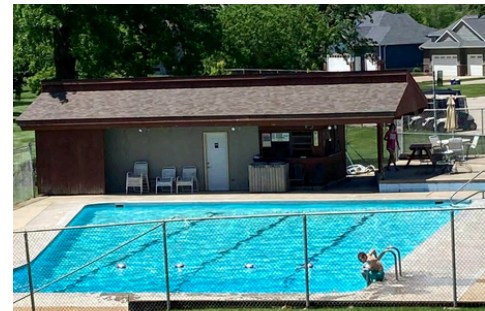
## The pool will be opening soon!

## Men's Match Play Tournament Starts May 27

### Tournament Info:

- Start Date: Wednesday, May 27
- Format: Net Match Play – bracket style
- Divisions: Two brackets — one for lower and one for higher handicaps
- Eligibility: Must have an established handicap
- Sign-Up: Lower hallway (near locker rooms) by Sunday, May 24
- Brackets Posted: In the Men's Locker Room & Creek Bed Hallway

### How It Works:

- Each round has 3 weeks to schedule and complete your match
- Players contact each other directly to set tee times
- Round 1 deadline: Tuesday, June 16
- Handicap strokes calculated using 85% of the difference between players
- Example: 8 vs. 13 handicap = 5 strokes → 85% = 4.25 → round to 4 strokes
- The higher-handicap player gets 4 strokes on the 4 hardest holes
