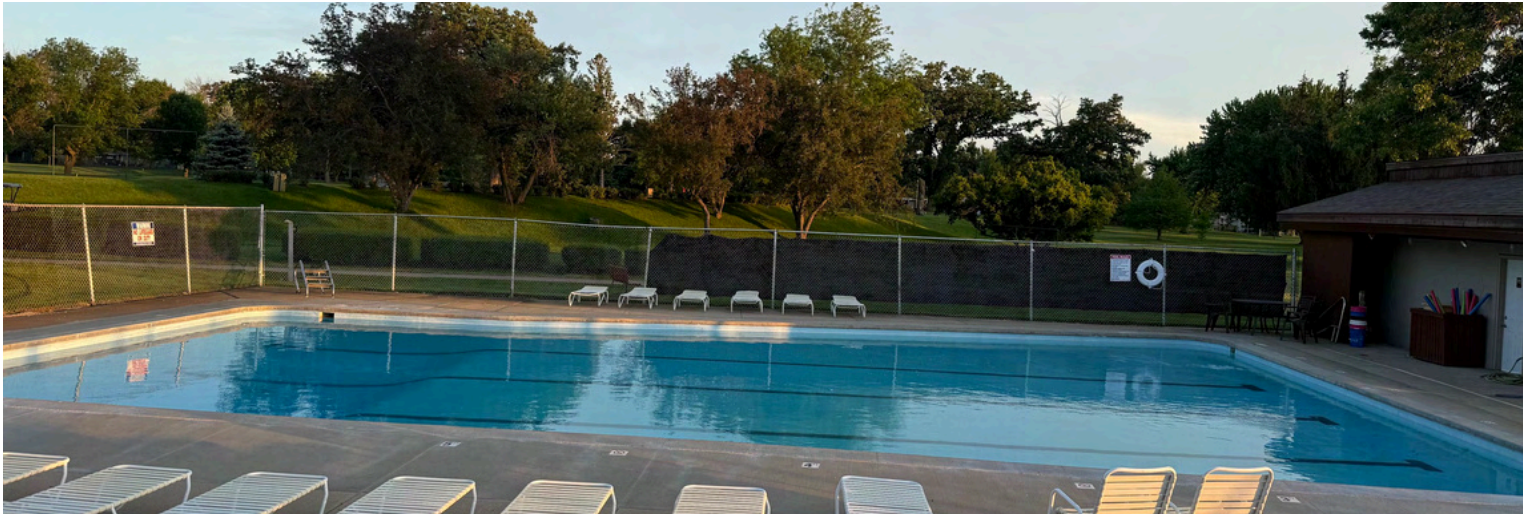

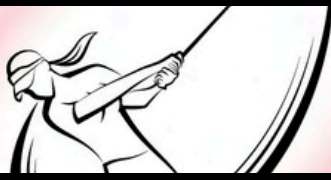
Aqua Relles To Perform at Indian Creek Country Club

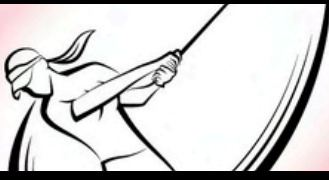

Men's Match Play



Round 1 Must Be Completed By Tuesday June 16

Tournament Info:

- Start Date: Wednesday, May 27
- Format: Net Match Play – bracket style
- Divisions: Two brackets — one for lower and one for higher handicaps
- Brackets Posted: In the Men's Locker Room

How It Works:

- Each round has 3 weeks to schedule and complete your match
- Players contact each other directly to set tee times
- Round 1 deadline: Tuesday, June 17
- Handicap strokes calculated using 85% of the difference between players
- Example: 8 vs. 13 handicap = 5 strokes → 85% = 4.25 → round to 4 strokes
- The higher-handicap player gets 4 strokes on the 4 hardest holes
- Player phone number sheet is available in the Men's Locker Room by the tournament bracket.

JULY 12 AND 13

Mark your calendars for the annual **Men's Club Championship on July 12th & 13th!** This event has been a tradition for over **50 years**, offering a great opportunity for **all skill levels** to compete or just enjoy a round with fellow members.

Key Info:

The event will take place on Saturday, July 12th and Sunday, July 13th. **Tee times starting at 7:30 AM both days.** The sign-up deadline is Wednesday, July 9th at noon, and the **entry fee is \$60.** Sign up in the hallway!

Event Details:

The tournament is either a 36-hole or 45-hole event depending on your performance. On Saturday, you'll play 18 holes, and then on Sunday, you'll play another 18 holes. **For the Championship Flight and other low scores** close to the lead from other flights, an **additional 9 holes will be played on Sunday afternoon** to determine the Open Champion. This ensures that the golfer with the **lowest 45-hole score will be crowned Men's Club Champion.**

The event is open to men **ages 16+** who have an established **GHIN Handicap.** Players will be **preflighted based on their handicaps** to ensure fair competition. A flighted skins game will be available each day.

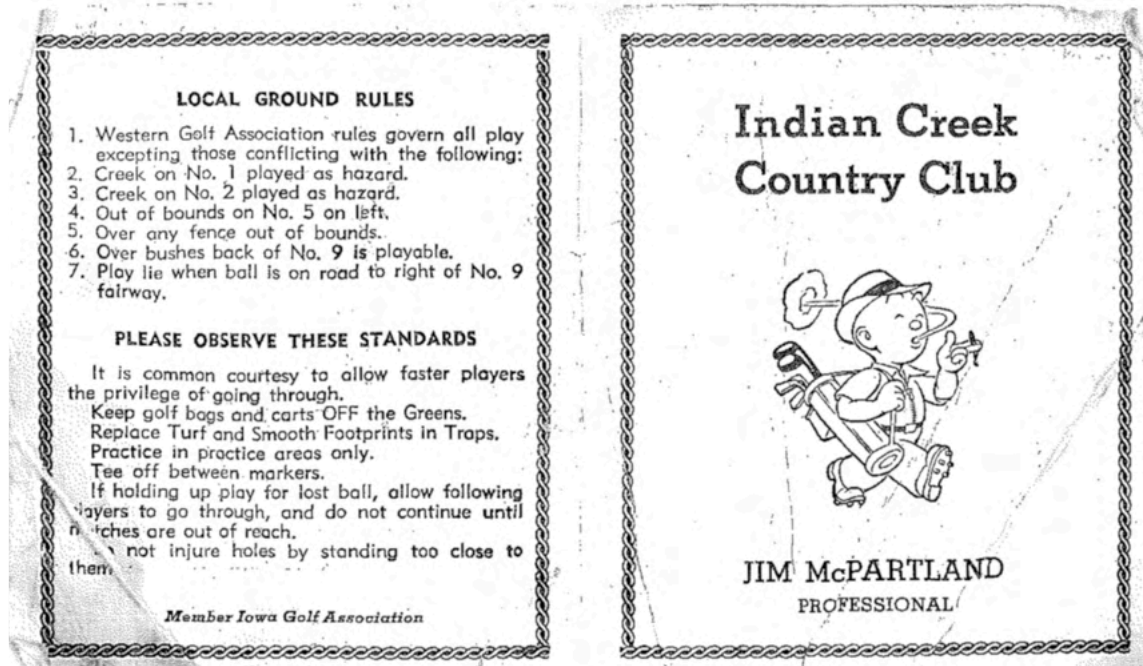

Scorecards

Indian Creek Country Club

Jim McPartland era scorecard. Estimated to be in the mid-to-late 1950s. Notice the hole order, and women's Par 37. Hole #3 on the scorecard is a par 3. Hole #4 on the scorecard (present day #7) was a par 5 for women. Current day hole routing on this scorecard is 1-2-6-7-5-3-4-8-9. This is believed to be the original routing of the Marion Country Club.

PLEASE FOLLOW THESE RULES OF COMMON COURTESY

1. Players looking for a lost ball should allow other matches through, and they should not continue play until these matches are out of reach.
2. It is common courtesy to allow faster players the privilege of going through.
3. Turf cut or displaced by a player should be at once replaced and pressed down with the foot. Please instruct your caddy.
4. Players should see that their caddies do not injure the holes by standing close to them.

Gasway Shoots Hole-in-One To Win Club Match

Jack Gasway used the first hole-in-one he ever shot to win his quarterfinal match in the third flight of the Indian Creek Country club's men's golf tourney Saturday.

Gasway holed out his eight-iron shot from the tee on the No. 6 hole. That ace gave him a one-up edge in his match with J. B. Anderson, and Gasway went on to win the match by that score in 18 holes.
