POOL RULES & POLICIES

NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY

SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK

Children under age 14 must be accompanied by a parent, guardian, or designated supervising adult at all times.

MEMBERS & GUESTS

- The pool is reserved for Indian Creek members and their invited guests.
- All members and guests must check in with the pool attendant upon arrival.
- Guest fee: \$5.00 per person.
- Guest fees may be paid inside the clubhouse or charged directly to the member's account through the pool attendant.
- Guests paying inside the clubhouse should bring their receipt to the pool attendant for verification.
- Members are responsible for all guest fees and the conduct of their guests.
- Babysitters, grandparents, or other caregivers supervising member children may accompany those children at no charge when attending solely to supervise member children using the pool.

CHILD SUPERVISION

- Children under age 14 may not be left unattended at the pool.
- Members may not drop off children and leave the premises.
- Parents, guardians, and supervising adults are responsible for the safety and behavior of children in their care.
- The baby pool is reserved for children age 5 and under.
- A supervising adult must be present at all times in the baby pool area.

POOL SAFETY

- No running.
- No pushing, dunking, wrestling, or dangerous horseplay.
- Standing still diving is permitted in the deep end only. No running starts.
- Hands must be above the head when entering the water on all dives.
- No flips, sailor dives, flying squirrels, back dives, or other dangerous entries into the water.
- No flotation devices or floaties are allowed in the deep end.
- Do not swing, jump, or dive from ladders.
- Do not hang on, sit on, pull on, or play on the deep end rope.
- Soft throwing balls and toys only.
- Activities must not interfere with or endanger other patrons.

ADULT SWIM

- Adult Swim takes place every hour on the hour for 10 minutes.
- During Adult Swim, the main pool is reserved for adults.

WEATHER POLICY

- The pool will be cleared immediately when lightning is seen or thunder is heard.
- All swimmers and guests must leave the water and pool deck area and seek shelter inside the clubhouse.
- The pool will remain closed for a minimum of 30 minutes after the last lightning strike or thunder.
- Pool staff and management have final authority regarding weather-related closures.

FOOD & BEVERAGES

- No glass containers of any kind are permitted inside the pool fence area.
- No glass bottles, cups, dishes, goggles, or other glass items are allowed.
- Outside alcohol is strictly prohibited.
- Per Iowa law, all alcohol consumed on club property must be purchased through Indian Creek Country Club.
- Coolers are permitted but are subject to inspection by pool staff.
- Food and beverages are available for purchase in The Creeke Bed during normal operating hours.

CLUBHOUSE & CLUB GROUNDS

- Shirts and shoes are required when entering the clubhouse.
 - Locker rooms are available for changing and restroom use.
 - Swimming attire is limited to the pool area only.
 - Swimming attire is not permitted on the golf course, practice green, or other club grounds.
 - Bicycles must be parked in the designated bike rack and may not be ridden in the parking lot, pool area, or clubhouse grounds.

CONDUCT & ENFORCEMENT

- Be respectful of other members, guests, and staff.
 - Excessive yelling, screaming, or disruptive behavior is not permitted.
 - Any conduct that interferes with the enjoyment of others will not be permitted.
 - Pool attendants, Certified Pool Operators (CPOs), management, and the Board of Directors have the authority to enforce all pool rules.
 - Pool attendants, CPOs, management, and the Board of Directors may deny, suspend, or terminate pool privileges for violations of pool rules or unsafe conduct.
 - All pool rules will be strictly enforced.

BABY POOL

- The baby pool is reserved for children age 5 and under.
- A parent, guardian, or supervising adult must be present at all times.
- The baby pool gate must remain closed at all times.
- Older children are not permitted in the baby pool.
- The baby pool may not open at the same time as the main pool.
- The baby pool may close before the main pool.
- Baby pool hours may vary based on staffing, maintenance requirements, weather conditions, and water quality requirements.
- Operation of the baby pool requires additional pumping, draining, and water testing procedures.
- Pool staff, CPOs, and management reserve the right to close the baby pool at any time for maintenance, safety, or water quality purposes.
